



## **Portfolio requirements for candidates who are non-Polish citizens applying for admission to full-time first-cycle studies in architektura/Architecture (2026/2027)**

The portfolio should be uploaded to the recruitment system between 12 May and 9 July 2026.

The purpose of the portfolio is to evaluate the candidate's artistic skills, especially:

- mapping three-dimensional space on a two-dimensional drawing surface,
- applying the principles of perspective and chiaroscuro,
- using spatial imagination.

The portfolio is a digital documentation of the candidate's own work (photos, scans). Also, it should include:

- original drawings or graphic works (max. 8 works), combined in one file in jpg or pdf format;
- at least 3 drawings works, completed in pencil on a 50x70 format, with the given subject matter:
  - the human figure in space (a figure and immediate surroundings – drawing made by hand from nature, without the use of a ruler)
  - local architecture (an object and immediate environment – drawing made by hand from nature, without the use of a ruler)
  - spatial composition (a composition consisting of at least 5 elements with different textures and materials (glass, fabric, metal, wood, vegetation), the elements of which may overlap - drawing from the imagination without using a ruler.

The subject matter of the works should show space drawn from nature or from the imagination and take into account the principles of perspective, proper composition of the work, framing, chiaroscuro etc.

The portfolio will be assessed by the Recruitment Commission in terms of the candidate's aesthetic and drawing skills. The following will be assessed:

- application of the principles of perspective (convergent, aerial);
- the use of chiaroscuro, diversity of textures/materials;
- representation of greenery;
- appropriate scaling of additional elements;
- work composition.

By uploading the portfolio to the recruitment system, the candidates declare that all works included in the portfolio have been created by themselves. Poznan University of Technology reserves the right to request the original works.

## **Portfolio requirements for candidates who are non-Polish citizens applying for admission to full-time second-cycle studies in architektura/Architecture (2026/2027)**

The portfolio should be uploaded to the recruitment system between 12 May and 15 September 2026.

The portfolio presents the candidate's authorial output to date in the field of architectural design and drawing skills, being documented of (photos, scans) produced during the course of study and in the individual mode.

Accepted file formats: jpg, pdf. *Each point in the portfolio should be uploaded as a separate file containing the candidate's digitised work (1 to 4 files). In addition, candidates are required to upload two separate files presenting their diploma thesis.\**

The portfolio will be assessed by the Recruitment Commission based on the following:

- the correctness of the architectural, functional and formal solutions adopted;
- aesthetic (graphic layout of the portfolio, clarity of the message);
- the candidate's drawing skills (imagination, perspective, proportions).

By uploading the portfolio to the recruitment system, the candidates declare that all works included in the portfolio have been created by themselves. Poznan University of Technology reserves the right to request the original works.

Detailed portfolio requirements:

### **MANDATORY PART**

#### **1. DIPLOMA THESIS\*:**

- 1) Engineering/Bachelor's diploma thesis – written part;
- 2) Engineering/Bachelor's diploma thesis – graphic part (min. 3 boards).

#### **2. PORTFOLIO:**

- 1) Architectural designs - projections, sections, development plan, details, short description of technical solutions, visualizations, conceptual sketches, photos, mock-ups - the best 3 designs, 1 design on 1 board.
- 2) Urban designs - list of land surfaces, projections, cross-sections of the land, visualizations, details, short description - the best 3 designs, 1 design on 1 board.
- 3) Graphic works - up to 8 works, including at least 3 works made with pencil. The subject matter of the works should show a space drawn from nature or imagination and take into account the principles of perspective, proper work composition, framing, chiaroscuro, etc.

### **ADDITIONAL PART:**

3. PROJECTS\*\* completed during internships, along with a document confirming the completion of internships and references.
