

Ordinance No. 15 of the Rector of Poznan University of Technology of March 11, 2020.
(RO / III / 15/2020)

on the operation of Student Dormitories of Poznan University of Technology

Pursuant to Article 23 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85), in connection with the Act of 2 March 2020 on special solutions related to preventing, counteracting and combating COVID-19, other infectious diseases and emergencies caused by them (Journal of Laws, item 374) **it is ordered as follows:**

§1

During the period of validity of Regulation No. 14 of the Rector of Poznan University of Technology of March 11, 2020, students currently residing in student dormitories are obliged to leave them in order to prevent the SARS-CoV-2 virus from spreading.

§2

In the case of checking out of a person accommodated for the period specified in the Ordinance referred to in § 1, the fee paid for the current period of accommodation shall be treated as the fee for the next period.

§3

Only persons conditionally accommodated and authorized PUT employees may stay in Student Dormitories.

§4

In exceptionally justified, documented cases, the decision on conditional accommodation is taken by the head of the PUT Student Housing Estate. The student may not appeal against a decision refusing accommodation.

§5

In order to create a student observation zone in PUT Student Dormitories (in case anyone gets infected with a coronavirus), the head of the Student Housing Estate has the right to transfer people to other rooms or other Student Dormitories.

§6

1. In particularly justified emergency cases, relocations may take place during the student's absence. Then a commission composed of:
 - a) head of the Student Housing Estate,
 - b) an employee of the Student Housing Estate administrationdocument the room's equipment and appearance in both descriptive and photographic form.
2. Personal belongings will be transferred to the Dormitory's deposit.
3. The student cannot appeal against the decision on relocation.

§7

1. During the period of validity of the Regulation referred to in § 1, it is prohibited to organize meetings and occasional events in Student Dormitories.
2. Failure to comply with this recommendation will result in an immediate check-out.

§8

This Ordinance shall enter into force on the day of signature.
