

Resolution No. 192/2020-2024 of the Senate of Poznan University of Technology of 24 April 2024

on the adoption of a curriculum of studies for the field of study Safety and Quality Engineering

Pursuant to Article 28 Section 1 Point 11 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 742, as amended), and after reviewing the opinion of the Senate Education Committee, the Academic Senate hereby **adopts** the curriculum of studies – Annex to the Resolution – for the following:

The adopted learning outcomes are consistent with the descriptors defined at level 6 of the Polish Qualifications Framework.
