



**Resolution No. 192/2020-2024
of the Senate of Poznan University of Technology
of 24 April 2024**

on the adoption of a curriculum of studies for the field of study *Safety and Quality Engineering*

Pursuant to Article 28 Section 1 Point 11 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 742, as amended), and after reviewing the opinion of the Senate Education Committee, the Academic Senate hereby **adopts** the curriculum of studies – Annex to the Resolution – for the following:

field of study: ***Safety and Quality Engineering***

level of studies: ***first-cycle studies***

profile of studies: ***general academic***

form of studies: ***full-time, part-time***

field of science: ***Social Sciences; Technical and Engineering Sciences***

discipline: ***Management and Quality Studies (55% – major), Mechanical Engineering (25%), Safety Engineering (20%)***

professional title conferred on a graduate: ***inżynier [Engineer]***

ISCED classification: ***1022 Occupational Health and Safety***

language of instruction: ***Polish***

The adopted learning outcomes are consistent with the descriptors defined at level 6 of the Polish Qualifications Framework.

This Resolution shall enter into force on the day of its adoption, with effect from the winter semester of the 2024/2025 academic year.
